## Sharing your experience in installing Adobe Creative Cloud- Dreamweaver





Let's begin installing the HTML editor authoring tool - **Adobe Dreamweaver** on your PC or Mac that you will be using in building and creating web pages.

You will share your experience and challenges/ issues if any that you encountered during the installation of the software.

### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. You will need to subscribe to Adobe Creative Cloud so that you can install Dreamweaver from the Creative Cloud desktop app.

2.  Once you purchase the monthly student subscription, you will need to install the Adobe Creative Cloud App through the link above.  
Below is the shortcut icon link that will appear on your desktop when the app is installed.



3. Once you have the App, you can then install **Dreamweaver** through the App.  
Look for the Dreamweaver icon and click on **Install**.

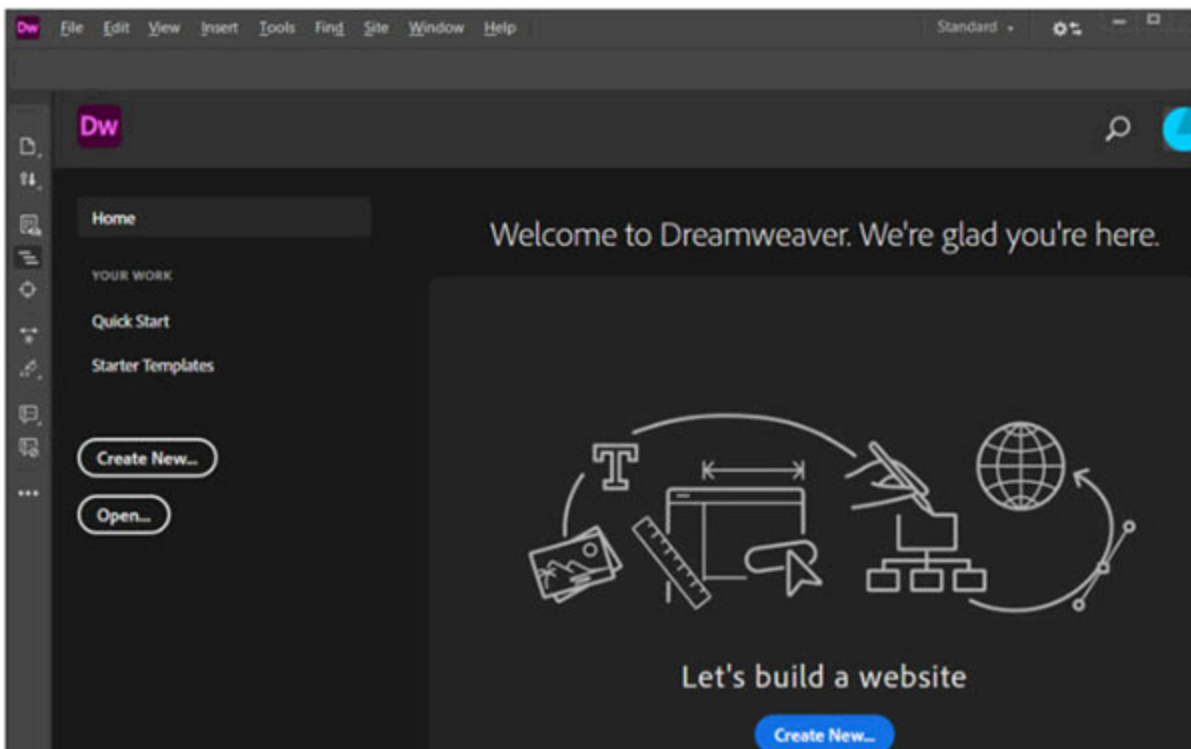
